

Iris Nell Weaver
February 26, 1932 - June 6, 2016

Iris Nell "Boots" Weaver, 84, died on Monday, June 6, 2016 at her home. Born the youngest of 10 children, she was a daughter to Grover Cleveland and Alma Goodson Waycaster. A graduate of Hatley High School, she married Wayne Hansel Weaver on August 27, 1948; he died on October 25, 1984. Prior to her retirement, she worked as a purchasing agent for the Blue Bell Company and she was faithful member of the Amory Church of Christ. She enjoyed quilting, reading, and watching the St. Louis Cardinals. She was known throughout her family for her sourdough bread otherwise referred to by her grandchildren as "granny bread." For her final wishes, she requested that her body be used for the advancement of medicine through the University of Mississippi Medical Center.

A memorial service honoring her life will be at 3 p.m. on Thursday, June 16, 2016 at the Amory Church of Christ with Philip Hathcock and Wayne Howell officiating. Cleveland-Moffett Funeral Home is in charge of the arrangements.
